# If your child is late or absent from school

It is a legal requirement that your child attends school. Therefore, if your child is not in school by the time registration takes place at 8.55am, and we have had no notification from parents to advise us of this, and why – our office staff have to telephone you to gain this information.

You can help by telephoning the school before this time. If you ring and the lines are busy, you can leave a message and this will be picked up as soon as is possible.

## Requests for pupil absence in term time

It is a legal requirement that your child attends school. We ask that parents understand that you child should be in school during term time. Time away from learning is difficult to catch up on – especially as lessons build on each other.

Holiday requests are not permitted and it is only in exceptional circumstances that this time can be granted. All Headteachers have guidelines that they must follow.
