### **Lates**

5 minutes late every day means missing about 3 days of school every year!

### **Attendance**

= Best chance of success in learning and social development
 - 91% = Will make it difficult to catch up on learning.
 - 86% = Will make it harder to make progress
 and under = Cause for concern. Your child will make little progress.
 Legal action could be taken.
